### Do not use this product

■ if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a physician or pharmacist before taking this product.

Ask a physician before use if you have ■ a cough that lasts or is chronic such as occurs with smoking, asthma or emphysema ■ a cough that occurs with too much phlegm (mucus) ■ heart disease ■ high blood pressure ■ thyroid disease

■ diabetes ■ trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland ■ glaucoma ■ a breathing problem such as emphysema or chronic bronchitis. Ask a physician or pharmacist before use if you are taking sedatives or tranquilizers.

### When using this product

- excitability may occur, especially in children
   may cause marked drowsiness
   avoid alcoholic drinks
   alcohol, sedatives, and tranquilizers may increase drowsiness
- be careful when driving a motor vehicle or operating machinery
- Stop use and ask a physician if nervousness, dizziness, or sleeplessness occur cough or nasal congestion persists for more than 1 week, tends to recur, or is accompanied by a fever, rash or persistent headache. These could be signs of a serious condition.

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

### Keep out of the reach of children.

In case of an accidental overdose, seek professional help or contact a Poison Control Center immediately.

### **Directions** Do not exceed recommended dosage.

### Adults and children 12 years of age and over:

2 teaspoonfuls (10 mL) every 6 hours, not to exceed 8 teaspoonfuls (40 mL) in 24 hours.

### Children 6 to under12 years of age:

1 teaspoonful (5 mL) every 6 hours, not to exceed 4 teaspoonfuls (20 mL) in 24 hours.
